Assessment

Southern Good Faith Fund will assess each student's financial aid and supportive service needs, career interests and also conduct an aptitude assessment and an academic skill assessment.

Individual Career Plan

Our Counselors work with each student to develop an Individual Career Plan that will serve as a road map. The Individual Career Plan includes short and long-term goals and guides students from choosing a career, to becoming employed, to reaching their short and long-term career goals.

Customized Pathways

The pathways are designed so that an individual can enter them at the point that matches their current education and skill levels.

Portfolio Credit

Students can get a jump start on their education by turning their life and work experience into college credit. Students can earn up to 15 credits for technical courses for the education and learning they've acquired outside the classroom.

Steps Along The Path

At each stage along the pathway, we work with students to find and retain employment or help them enroll in the next step at the college.

Basic & Workplace Education

Some students may need to work on their basic and workplace education skills before starting a job or entering college.

A student's Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE) score is used to determine the need for GED certification, Adult Education, Basic Skill Training, and WAGE certification.
